

CAMPINGCARAFVANING GORGES DU CHAMBON

INTERIOR REGULATIONS

1. Conditions of admission.

To be able to enter, to install equipment and to stay on the land of Gorges du Chambon, authorisation of the management or its representative is needed. This is an obligation to maintain the campsite in smooth running condition and in good order, and out of respect of the current on-site regulations and the commitment to conform to them.

2 Police formalities.

Every person, before staying on the campsite for one night, must, beforehand, present to the management or its representative their passport or ID card and fill in the relevant forms required by the police.

Minors not accompanied by their parents will not be admitted without written authorisation by them.

3 Installation

The tent or caravan and the material appertaining to it must be settled on the dedicated site, conforming to the directives given by the management.

4 Reception office.

All information needed on the services offered by the campsite can be found in the reception office. This includes information on obtaining food and supplies, sporting installations, regional tourist information and miscellaneous addresses that may be useful.

A complaint box is available for the use of campers. Complaints will not be taken in consideration unless they are signed and dated.

To be considered they must be specific and relate to recent events.

5 Payment

Payments are payable at the reception office. A list of charges is displayed at the campsite entrance and in the reception office. The sum due depends on the number of nights spend on the site. Users of the campsite are asked to advise the reception office of their departure on the day before. Campers who intent to leave before opening hours should make payment the day before their departure.

6 Noise – Silence – Animals.

Users of the campsite are requested not to make a noise that should annoy their neighbours. Excessive noise from radio etc should be adjusted accordingly. Closing of car doors and boots lids should be as discreet as possible.

The presence of animals is not authorised on the campsite or in the rented accommodation.

7 Visitors

After being authorised by the management or its representative visitors are allowed to enter the campsite under the responsibility of the campers who receive them.

The camper must receive the visitor or visitors at the reception office. If visitors are allowed to enter the campsite the camper receiving them must pay a fee inasmuch as the visitor has access to the services and installations of the campsite. This charge is displayed at the entrance of the campsite and in the reception office. Visitor's cars are not allowed on the campsite.

8 Circulation and parking vehicles.

There is a 10 km per hour speed limit within the campsite.

Driving within the campsite is forbidden between 10.00pm and 7.00am.

Only vehicles belonging to campers are allowed on the campsite.

Parking, strictly forbidden on the site usually occupied by tents, should not, furthermore, hinder circulation, nor prevent the installation of new arrivals.

9 Upkeep and appearance of installations

Everyone is asked to abstain from any action that could in anyway damage the property, the cleanliness and the appearance of the campsite. It is forbidden to empty wastewater into the installations specifically provided.

Household rubbish and scraps of all kinds should be placed in the rubbish bins provided.

Everyone is asked to abstain from any action that could damage the property, the hygiene and the appearance of the site and its installations, notably the sanitary installations.

Washing is strictly forbidden in anything other than the sinks supplied for this purpose. The hanging out of laundry, if the need arise, must be in the communal drying room.

However, it is tolerated until 10.00am near to accommodation, on condition that it is discreet and does not annoy neighbours. It must never be hung from trees. Flowerbeds and plants must be respected.

It is forbidden for the campers to hammer nails into trees, to cut branches or to remove and pick flowers. Personal demarcation of a site or installation is not permitted, nor is digging holes in the ground.

All damage to vegetation and to the land, or to the installations of the campsite will be charged to the perpetrator or his/her representative.

The site which will be used during the stay should be maintained and left in the state in which the camper would wish to find it.

10 Security.

a) Fire

Open fires (wood, coal etc.) are strictly forbidden.

Portable stoves must be maintained in good order and should not be used in dangerous conditions. In case of fire, the management must be advised immediately.

Fire extinguishers are to be used if necessary. There is a first aid kit in the reception office.

b) Theft

The management is responsible for objects left in the reception office and has obligation to make a general surveillance of the campsite. Campers maintain responsibility for their own site and should inform a person in charge if they see any suspicious act being committed. A safe is at the disposition of campers for objects of value, currency etc.

c) Activities

Within the scope of the activities organised by the management the camper is obliged to respect and to use the security measures recommended.

11 Games

Children must always be under parental supervision.

No strenuous or annoying games must be organised or take place near the installations. The games room cannot be used for rough/strenuous games.

The campsite riverbank allows for water games, fishing with a permit and canoeing. Access to the river is forbidden to unaccompanied children.

Numerous places on the campsite and proximity are wooded. Climbing trees is forbidden.

12 Swimming pool

Access to the swimming pool is forbidden to unaccompanied children. The swimming pool is not supervised. Supervision is the responsibility of parents. For reasons of hygiene the wearing of Tee shirts, shorts or Bermuda shorts is strictly forbidden in the swimming pool. Boys and men must wear swimming trunks.

13 Long-term storage.

No unaccompanied equipment may be left on the property without the agreement of the management and then only in the place indicated. A fee, the amount of which is displayed in the reception office can be found under "Garage Mort".

14 Public notices.

The current interior regulations are posted at the entrance to the campsite and in the reception office. Clients can receive a copy on application.

15 Infringement of interior regulations

In the case of a user disturbing the stay of others or of not respecting the arrangements of the current interior regulations, the management or its representative can orally, or in writing as judged necessary, instruct the perpetrator to cease all disturbances. In case of a serious or repetitive infractions of the interior regulations and after receiving warning from the management the rental contract may be terminated. In case of criminal infraction the management may call in the forces of law and orde
